DAY 1 | WELCOME TO BELGRADE Belgrade

Upon arrival in Belgrade, Serbia’s vibrant capital, your driver will welcome you and escort you to your hotel. Enjoy the sights of **New Belgrade**, featuring Socialist architecture and modern business centres, during the ride from Nikola Tesla Airport. After hotel *check-in*, use your free time to rest and prepare for the journey ahead. In the evening, we recommend a leisurely stroll through one of Belgrade’s oldest quarters to **Skadarlija**, the city’s bohemian heart. This charming 19th century cobbled street is lined with “**kafanas**” where you can enjoy delicious local specialties and traditional music.

DAY 2 | VIBRANT CAPITAL OF SERBIA Belgrade

On your first day in Serbia, you will embark on a walking and driving tour around Belgrade, starting at **Knez Mihailova Street**, the city’s bustling pedestrian zone, filled with shops, cafes, and historic buildings.

EXPERIENCE MORE / Serbian Morning Routine: Your guide will take you to a hidden gem close to the main district, **the city’s oldest tavern** intriguingly known as “?” (Question Mark), where you’ll try Serbia’s most cherished traditional drinks: **coffee and rakija**, but also learn about the UNESCO-protected art of making “**šljivovica**”, Serbia’s renowned plum brandy.

Having started the day like a true local, we will walk through **the historical Belgrade Fortress and Kalemegdan Park** and be amazed by the view of the mighty Sava and Danube rivers.

Crossing Branko’s Bridge into New Belgrade, our panorama tour begins. You’ll experience the bold **Brutalism architecture** and see the emerging **Belgrade Waterfront**, a symbol of the city’s modern transformation. Continuing the journey, you’ll gain **insight into Serbia’s past**, from its 19th century struggle for independence



to its turbulent 1990s. We’ll stop for a visit and devote time to the impressive **Temple of Saint Sava**, the symbol of the city and the fourth-largest Orthodox temple in the world, adorned with stunning mosaics.

Our tour concludes in **the lively heart of Serbia’s bustling capital** - The Republic Square, having offered you an insight into both the city’s and the country’s diverse culture, heritage, and history.

EXPERIENCE MORE / Belgrade Sundown Cruise: Set sail on an enchanting evening **river cruise** through Belgrade, where the grand Sava and Danube Rivers unveil the city’s splendour. Cruise past iconic landmarks, absorb the vibrant riverside ambience, and capture stunning views of Belgrade’s **skyline, bridges, and historic landmarks**.

DAY 3 | “SERBIAN TUSCANY” DELIGHTS Belgrade - Šumadija Region - Zlatibor Mountain

Morning *check-out* from Belgrade marks the beginning of your journey southwards, towards the heart of Serbia. You’ll explore **Oplenac**, a place where royals are laid to rest and history comes to life.

EXPERIENCE MORE / Šumadija Royal Wine: Delve into a royal wine journey through the enchanting Šumadija region, often called **the “Serbian Tuscany”**. At one of Serbia’s leading century-old wineries, where natural beauty meets urban elegance, you will taste **three sorts of wine** crafted using traditional recipes and learn about **the Royal Karađorđević dynasty**, who led Serbia through pivotal moments in its history.

After this exquisite wine experience, continue to **Zlatibor Mountain**, home to Serbia’s first royal resort. *Check-in* to your mountain hotel and enjoy a leisurely walk through the picturesque town centre, followed by a delightful dinner of traditional Serbian cuisine typical to the region.

EXPERIENCE MORE / Zlatibor Gourmet Session: Explore **the essence of Serbian cuisine** at one of Zlatibor Mountain’s finest **traditional kafanas**. Indulge in rich **ajvar**, creamy **kajmak**, artisan-cured meats, and hearty traditional **pies or proja**. Join us for this unforgettable dining experience and try **the rich, irresistible flavours** of Serbian cuisine against the stunning backdrop

of Zlatibor’s natural beauty.

Overnight: Zlatibor Mountain

DAY 4 | VIVID WESTERN SERBIA Zlatibor Mountain - Wooden-Town - Šargan Eight - Višegrad - Sarajevo

After *check-out*, continue to the ethno village **Drvengrad** (Wooden-Town), built by renowned film director Emir Kusturica. This village features natural wood constructions, the Mečavnik Hotel, galleries, shops, a cinema, and a church, hosting the **Küstendorf Film and Music Festival** since 2008.

EXPERIENCE MORE / Šargan Eight Railroad: You will truly experience the charm of the mountains while riding the authentic, **retro “Nostalgia” train** along the narrow gauge heritage railway, **Šargan Eight**. This railway, named for its figure-eight shape, takes you from the base of Šargan Mountain and transports you back in time as you enjoy stunning scenery, numerous tunnels, and viaduct.

The tour concludes in **Višegrad**, with a visit to **Andrićgrad**, or Stone-Town, built by Kusturica on the emerald Drina River, featuring cultural facilities and the UNESCO-protected bridge. After lunch, continue to **Sarajevo**, the capital of Bosnia and Herzegovina, for hotel *check-in*.

Overnight: Sarajevo

DAY 5 | BALKAN SOUL CAPITAL Sarajevo

Our Sarajevo exploration starts at **Vječna Vatra** (Eternal Flame), from where we will delve deeper in the cultural and historical treasures and engage **all your senses** - sight, sound, and taste - offering an extraordinary experience that truly captures the essence of Sarajevo.

EXPERIENCE MORE / A Taste of History: Start your Sarajevo tour with none other than a taste of the city’s **culinary crown jewel - the famous burek**. Enjoy this savoury pastry at a local bakery before we continue through the vibrant Ferhadiya pedestrian zone and discover how Sarajevo’s **diverse Orthodox, Catholic, and Islamic cultures influence its rich traditions and heritage**. Our journey continues to **Baščaršija**, the heart of Sarajevo’s old town, where you’ll find some of **the best ćevapi** around, a minced meat dish which the entire Balkan swears by. In the city centre



area, make sure to experience **the local tradition of coffee**, a key part of Sarajevo’s daily life. We’ll also visit iconic sites like the **Vjećnica (City Hall)**, wrapping **the entire tale** of this soulful city. End this unforgettable experience with a taste of heavenly **baklava** and savour the true essence of Sarajevo’s history and cuisine.

In the afternoon, take the opportunity to **explore Sarajevo at your own pace**, revisit your favourite sights or unwind in one of the city’s cosy cafes.

DAY 6 | THE BEAUTY OF HERZEGOVINA Sarajevo - Mostar - Trebinje

Today, bid farewell to Sarajevo after *check-out* and embark on a journey to one of the Balkan Peninsula’s most stunning cities, **Mostar**. Begin with a walking tour visiting the iconic **Old Bridge**, a UNESCO landmark, Koski Mehmed Pasha Mosque, the Crooked Bridge, and the old tanner’s quarter, Tabhana.

EXPERIENCE MORE / Mostar Copper Artistry: Step into a workshop in Mostar’s Old Town to explore **the ancient art of copper modelling**. Guided by a master artisan, create stunning **jewellery pieces** or intricate **reliefs**, delving into Bosnia’s rich **coppersmithing tradition** passed down through generations.

Free time in Mostar to enjoy lunch on the banks of **the Neretva River**, with an amazing view of the bridge that rises above you.

The day continues to **Trebinje**, starting with a visit to **Hercegovačka Gračanica**, a Serbian Orthodox monastery modeled after the famous Gračanica in Kosovo. Perched on a hill overlooking the town, it offers breathtaking views, exquisite frescoes, and a tranquil atmosphere, a perfect place to experience Herzegovina’s spiritual heritage.

Afterward, explore the heart of **Trebinje**, a charming town with a captivating mix of cultural influences. The tour includes a visit to **Arslanagića Bridge**, a historic stone bridge whose peaceful atmosphere takes you 400 years back in time, followed by a stop at **Poet’s Square**, where sixteen century old plane trees add to the town’s timeless charm, before checking in to your hotel.

DAY 7 | THE MEDITERRANEAN ESSENCE
Trebinje - Perast - Kotor - Dubrovnik

After *check-out*, explore Trebinje’s **local market** before continuing towards Montenegro.

Amidst the friendly chatter of vendors and the inviting aromas of fresh produce, indulge in creamy, fresh cheese, flavourful dried meats, and sun-ripened fruits, all grown by small local producers using time-honoured techniques.*

Wave farewell to Herzegovina as you journey towards **Montenegro’s Boka Bay**, renowned for its picturesque landscapes and historical significance. Your first stop is the town of **Perast**, a charming baroque-style settlement nestled in the heart of Boka Bay.

EXPERIENCE MORE / Our Lady of the Rocks: *From Perast, you have the opportunity to discover a quiet wonder of the Boka Bay, the picturesque island of Our Lady of the Rocks, a manmade island is home to a church with valuable paintings by local artists, silver votive tablets, and a famous sacred tapestry.*

Arrive in **Kotor** for a guided tour of this **UNESCO site**, including ancient churches and the Cathedral of Saint Tryphon.

The final destination of the day is **Dubrovnik**, one of the most significant monuments in the world and one of Europe’s best preserved walled cities, known since the 7th century. Hotel *check-in*.

DAY 8 | THE PEARL OF THE ADRIATIC
Dubrovnik

Discover the true essence of Dubrovnik, the “Pearl of the Adriatic”, as you explore its iconic landmarks, from the bustling **Stradun** to the historic Placa Square and beyond. Immerse yourself in the enchanting atmosphere of this city, where the breathtaking settings of “**Game of Thrones**” come to life. Uncover the fascinating tales of the **Republic of Ragusa** and experience firsthand why Dubrovnik stands as one of the world’s most captivating destinations.

Our mission is to showcase **Dubrovnik from every angle**, allowing you to fully embrace its unique charm. After the city tour, we recommend

making the most of your **free time** by having lunch atop the city walls, taking a **cable car to Srđ Hill** for breathtaking views, walking the **2 km City Walls** for a stunning perspective from above. In the evening, we suggest taking a **sunset cruise on the Karaka**, a replica of a traditional 16th century wooden galleon, and admire the breathtaking views of the old town and the centuries-old impregnable walls of Dubrovnik from the sea.

DAY 9 | THE DALMATIAN COAST
Dubrovnik - Pelješac Peninsula - Split

After *check-out*, drive along the scenic **Dalmatian coast**, enjoying views of Croatian islands and charming villages. Stop briefly in the **City of Ston** on the Pelješac Peninsula to taste its famous oysters and photograph the Ston Walls.

EXPERIENCE MORE / Pelješac Handcrafted Wines: *Pelješac Peninsula is known for its breathtaking vineyards and celebrated wines. Experience the essence of Dalmatian wine-making as a local winery invites you to try the robust Plavac Mali, the region’s signature red wine, made from vines hand-tended as they grow in rocky terrain.*

The day concludes in **Split**, the largest city in Dalmatia. Enter through the **Golden Gate** and wander through narrow cobblestone streets, where bustling markets, charming cafés, and hidden courtyards reveal the rich history and timeless grandeur of the **Diocletian’s Palace**. Visit the **former Temple of Jupiter**, followed by the Cathedral of Saint Domnius, the oldest Catholic cathedral still in its original structure. Stroll along the lively **Riva promenade**, soaking up the Mediterranean sun and vibrant atmosphere. End the day with a hotel *check-in*.

DAY 10 | HVAR ISLAND ADVENTURE
Split - Hvar Island - Split

To start your day, drive to the ferry port and board a **high-speed catamaran** bound for Hvar, Croatia’s renowned island gem.

Hvar, a charming island-city with **Venetian architecture**, is known for its traffic-free cobbled

streets lined with restaurants and bars. On your walking tour, explore the harbour, Renaissance Cathedral, Benedictine Convent, Franciscan Monastery, and Church of Our Lady of Mercy.

We’ve set aside plenty of free time for you to fully enjoy all that the island has to offer. Based on your interests, we recommend you to: Enjoy a delightful Mediterranean lunch at a local restaurant, relax on the sun-kissed beaches, embark on a boat excursion to discover the enchanting **Pakleni Islands**, or explore the picturesque trails to Milna Bay for a memorable adventure.

In the late afternoon, return to **Split**, with departure timing subject to seasonal variations.

DAY 11 | THE DEVIL’S GARDEN
Split - Plitvice Lakes NP - Zagreb

Today, we bid farewell to the stunning Dalmatian coast, and after *check-out* we head inland. Pass through charming villages, admire rolling hills, as you wave goodbye to the sparkling Adriatic Sea, before entering the mountainous landscape surrounding our next stop.

Start exploring **Plitvice Lakes National Park**, a beautiful park that contains **16 interconnected cascading lakes**. On old maps, it was called “Devil’s Garden” and it is the first site in the Balkans to get **UNESCO World Heritage status**.

The final stop of the day is the Croatian capital, **Zagreb**. After *checking into* your hotel, enjoy some free time to explore the city and savour a delightful dinner on your own.

Overnight: Zagreb

DAY 12 | FAREWELL, ZAGREB
Zagreb

After hotel *check-out*, it is time to conclude your Balkan tour with a Zagreb sightseeing tour, during which you will explore the city’s main attractions. Visit **Kaptol**, the medieval part of Zagreb, and the Franciscan monastery with its 13th century Church of Saint Francis. Walk around **Dolac**, Zagreb’s best-known farmers’ market, and admire the baroque architecture of the 18th century Church of Saint Mary. The tour will conclude in the heart of Zagreb, at **Ban Josip Jelačić’s monument**, placed in the square named after him.

As most of our clients decide to **extend their trip** within their own organisation, **transfer to the airport** at the end of the tour is not included in the overall price. Any guests who would like Balkan&more to organise a departure transfer on their behalf are welcome to contact us. End of services.
