Upon arrival in Belgrade, Serbia's vibrant capital, your driver will welcome you and escort you to your hotel. Enjoy the sights of New Belgrade, featuring Socialist architecture and modern business centres, during the ride from Nikola Tesla Airport. After hotel check-in, use your free time to rest and prepare for the journey ahead. In the evening, we recommend a leisurely stroll through one of Belgrade's oldest quarters to **Skadarlija**, the city's bohemian heart. This charming 19th century cobbled street is lined with "kafanas" where you can enjoy delicious local specialties and traditional music.

DAY 2 | VIBRANT CAPITAL OF SERBIA Belgrade


Overnight: Belgrade

On your first day in Serbia, you will embark on a walking and driving tour around Belgrade, starting at **Knez Mihailova Street**, the city's bustling pedestrian zone, filled with shops, cafes, and historic buildings.

EXPERIENCE MORE / Serbian Morning Routine: Your guide will take you to a hidden gem close to the main district, **the city's oldest tavern** intriguingly known as "?" (Question Mark), where you'll try Serbia's most cherished traditional drinks: coffee and rakija, but also learn about the UNESCO-protected art of making "šljivovica", Serbia's renowned plum brandy.

Having started the day like a true local, we will walk through the historical Belgrade Fortress and Kalemegdan Park and be amazed by the view of the mighty Sava and Danube rivers.

Crossing Branko's Bridge into New Belgrade, our panorama tour begins. You'll experience the bold Brutalism architecture and see the emerging Belgrade Waterfront, a symbol of the city's modern transformation. Continuing the journey, you'll gain insight into Serbia's past, from its 19th century struggle for independence



Our tour concludes in the lively heart of Serbia's bustling capital - The Republic Square, having offered you an insight into both the city's and the country's diverse culture, heritage, and history.

After this exquisite wine experience, continue to **Zlatibor Mountain**, home to Serbia's first royal resort. Check-in to your mountain hotel and enjoy a leisurely walk through the picturesque town centre, followed by a delightful dinner of traditional Serbian cuisine typical to the region.

You will truly experience the charm of the mountains while riding the authentic, retro "Nostalgia" train along the narrow gauge heritage railway, **Šargan Eight**. This railway, named for its figure-eight shape, takes you from the base of Šargan Mountain and transports you back in time as you enjoy stunning scenery, numerous tunnels, and viaduct.

The tour concludes in Višegrad, with a visit to Andrićgrad, or Stone-Town, built by Kusturica on the emerald Drina River, featuring cultural facilities and the UNESCO-protected bridge. After lunch, continue to Sarajevo, the capital of Bosnia and Herzegovina, for hotel check-in.

DAY 5 | BALKAN SOUL CAPITAL

Our Sarajevo exploration starts at Vječna Vatra (Eternal Flame), from where we will delve deeper in the cultural and historical treasures and engage all your senses - sight, sound, and taste - offering an extraordinary experience that truly captures the essence of Sarajevo.

your Sarajevo tour with none other than a taste of the city's culinary crown jewel - the famous burek. Enjoy this savoury pastry at a local bakery before we continue through the vibrant Ferhadiya pedestrian zone and discover how Sarajevo's diverse Orthodox, Catholic, and Islamic cultures influence its rich traditions and heritage. Our journey continues to **Baščaršija**, the heart of Sarajevo's old town, where you'll find some of the **best ćevapi** around, a minced meat dish which the entire Balkan swears by. In the city centre

area, make sure to experience the local tradition of coffee, a key part of Sarajevo's daily life. We'll also visit iconic sites like the Viećnica (City Hall). wrapping the entire tale of this soulful city. End this unforgettable experience with a taste of heavenly **baklava** and savour the true essence of Sarajevo's history and cuisine.

In the afternoon, take the opportunity to explore Sarajevo at your own pace, revisit your favourite sights or unwind in one of the city's cosy cafes.

DAY 6 | THE BEAUTY OF HERZEGOVINA Sarajevo - Mostar - Trebinje

Today, bid farewell to Sarajevo after check-out and embark on a journey to one of the Balkan Peninsula's most stunning cities, Mostar. Begin with a walking tour visiting the iconic Old Bridge, a UNESCO landmark, Koski Mehmed Pasha Mosque, the Crooked Bridge, and the old tanner's quarter, Tabhana.

EXPERIENCE MORE / Mostar Copper Artistry: Step into a workshop in Mostar's Old Town to explore the ancient art of copper modelling.

Guided by a master artisan, create stunning jewellery pieces or intricate reliefs, delving into Bosnia's rich coppersmithing tradition passed down through generations.

Free time in Mostar to enjoy lunch on the banks of the Neretva River, with an amazing view of the bridge that rises above you.

The day continues to **Trebinje**, starting with a visit to Hercegovačka Gračanica, a Serbian Orthodox monastery modeled after the famous Gračanica in Kosovo. Perched on a hill overlooking the town, it offers breathtaking views, exquisite frescoes, and a tranquil atmosphere, a perfect place to experience Herzegovina's spiritual heritage.

Afterward, explore the heart of Trebinje, a charming town with a captivating mix of cultural influences. The tour includes a visit to Arslanagića Bridge, a historic stone bridge whose peaceful atmosphere takes you 400 years back in time, followed by a stop at Poet's **Square**, where sixteen century old plane trees add to the town's timeless charm, before checking in to your hotel.

After check-out from Budva, the tour continues towards **Old Bar**, nestled at the foot of Mount Rumija, where centuries-old stone walls and winding cobbled streets tell the stories of Montenegro's past. Enjoy a leisurely walk through this **open-air museum**, where we recommend you to savour a coffee or indulge in a traditional dessert at one of the local cafés. We bid farewell to Montenegro and make our way into **Albania**, where our first destination promises a delightful introduction to the country's natural landscapes, sustainable practices and diverse gastronomic scene.

Experience: Feel the essence of Albanian agrotourism, where farm-to-table experience comes to life in the heart of the countryside. You'll get to know the local lifestyle while savouring dishes crafted from the finest organic products. Freshly prepared meats and an array of seasonal ingredients which are expertly transformed into a delightful tasting menu for lunch will demonstrate the true spirit of Albania's vibrant culinary traditions.

Drive to **Tirana**, the capital city of Albania as well as its largest city. Situated on the banks of the Lana River, Tirana has outstanding architecture, wide boulevards, parks, shops and cafés. The heart of Tirana is the Skanderbeg **Square**, dominated by the statue of Lord Skanderbeg, an Albanian hero and symbol of freedom and independence. During the sightseeing tour, you will be introduced to the architecture of the Mussolini period and see the city's most important landmarks, including the Et'hem Bey Mosque, the National Museum of History, the Clock Tower and the Presidential Palace. As you stroll through the central part of the city, you can enjoy the many murals and works of art painted on the buildings by various artists and understand why Tirana is known as "the city of colourful buildings".

Settle into your hotel, then we recommend visiting Blloku (the "Block"), Tirana's vibrant upmarket district, famous for its boutiques,

cafes, bars, and lively nightlife.

DAY 10 | HIGHLIGHTS OF ALBANIA Tirana - Berat - Durrës - Tirana

On today's journey through Albania's heritage and beauty, our first stop is the enchanting town of Berat, a UNESCO World Heritage site and the pride of Albanian architecture. This authentic town - often called the "town of a thousand windows" - beautifully blends Eastern and Western cultures, and tells the story of diverse traditions and civilisations that once thrived here. Beyond its historical charm, Berat is also a gourmet destination, renowned for traditional dishes like "pula me përshesh" and "corba e Tomorrit", served in authentic restaurants.

Further along the way, Durrës will welcome you with its vibrant seaside charm and rich atmosphere. As we stroll through this lively coastal city, you'll feel the energy of its ancient roots and modern rhythm. History resonates in the streets, as the sea breeze and lively promenades invite you to embrace the local ambience. This brief but memorable visit will leave you with a true taste of Albania's coastal

As you return to your Tirana hotel, enjoy a leisurely evening and take a moment to reflect on the unforgettable memories created today. You might also explore the lively Blloku area, famous for its eclectic blend of restaurants, stylish bars, and local shops that showcase the city's vibrant spirit.

DAY 11 | NORTH MACEDONIA ROUTES Tirana - Ohrid - Skopie

Check-out and wave goodbye to Tirana. On our way to the capital of North Macedonia, we will make a stop in **Ohrid**, the cradle of Slavic literacy. Thanks to its extraordinary natural beauty and rich historical and cultural heritage, Ohrid was proclaimed as both a Cultural and Natural World Heritage Site by UNESCO. One of the oldest lakes in the world will welcome you with a photographic setting, impeccably clear water that reflects the lake's picturesque high mountain surroundings. In the same area where the first Slavic university was founded, you will have the chance to visit over 300 Orthodox churches and monasteries.

Our final stop of the day is **Skopje**, where you'll check-in to your hotel and have the evening free to explore this vibrant capital city - consider enjoying a drink with views of the Vardar River, or sample traditional Macedonian cuisine at a cosy restaurant - try dishes like "tavče gravče" and sip a glass of "mastika" for an authentic

DAY 12 | SOUTHERN SOUL DISCOVERY Skopje - Matka Canyon - Skopje

Start your Skopje tour with a stroll through the **Old Bazaar**, the largest preserved bazaar in the Balkans. Cross the Stone Bridge near the Archaeological Museum towards Macedonia Square, featuring the "Warrior on a Horse" monument. In the modern part of the city, visit Porta Macedonia, the Memorial House of Mother Teresa, the Art Bridge, and statues of prominent North Macedonian figures.

Following the tour, we continue to the nearby Matka Canyon, known for its striking lake nestled among rugged cliffs and lush forests. Here, you can take a boat ride on the clear turquoise waters and enjoy stunning views of the canyon's dramatic landscape.

High up in the Rila Mountains lies the largest and most renowned monastery in Bulgaria, the Rila Monastery. Perched beneath Bulgaria's highest peak, Musala, and surrounded by breathtaking natural beauty, this UNESCO

World Heritage Site is renowned for its serene atmosphere and authentic charm. It stands as one of Bulgaria's most photogenic and peaceful locations, offering an unparalleled glimpse into the country's rich cultural and historical heritage.

Sofia is a modern, youthful Eastern European capital, distinguished by a unique combination of onion-domed churches, communist-style architecture and Ottoman legacy. The home to many of Bulgaria's finest museums, galleries and restaurants, Sofia will reveal to you its most interesting landmarks, such as the impressive Saint Alexander Nevsky Cathedral and Largo, one of the prime examples of Socialist Classicism architecture and one of Sofia's main landmarks. Finish the day by checking into your hotel in Sofia and rest well.
